4           (a) All monies received by the state of Wyoming from the  
5 secretary of the treasury of the United States under the provisions  
6 of the act of congress of February 25, 1920 (41 Stat. 437, 450; 30  
7 U.S.C. §§ 181, 191), as amended, or from lessees or authorized  
8 mine operators and all monies received by the state from its sale  
9 of production from federal mineral leases subject to the act of  
10 congress of February 25, 1920 (41 Stat. 437, 450; 30 U.S.C. §§  
11 181, 191) as amended, except as provided by subsection (b) of this  
12 section, shall be deposited into an account and the first two  
13 hundred million dollars (\$200,000,000.00) of revenues received in  
14 any fiscal year shall be distributed by the state treasurer as  
15 provided in this subsection. One percent (1%) of these revenues  
16 shall be credited to the general fund as an administrative fee,  
17 and the remainder shall be distributed as follows:

19           (iii) Except as provided by W.S. 9-4-605(a), and as  
20 otherwise provided in this paragraph, twenty-six and one-quarter  
21 percent (26 1/4%) to the highway fund, first subject to allocations

24 (e) Deposits into the account created by subsection (a) of  
25 this section shall be distributed as follows, subject to  
26 subsections (b) through (d) and (f) of this section:

28 (iv) To the highway fund, except for the fiscal years  
29 commencing ~~July 1, 2016 and July 1, 2017~~ July 1, 2021 through  
30 July 1, 2025, four and thirty-three hundredths percent (4.33%),  
31 except that if the total unencumbered revenues within the state  
32 park road account created by W.S. 24-14-102 are less than five  
33 hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) on July 1, 2001 or on July  
34 1 of any even-numbered year thereafter, the state treasurer shall  
35 first distribute revenues to that account in an amount equal to  
36 five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) less the total  
37 unencumbered revenues in the account on July 1 of that year. For  
38 the fiscal years commencing ~~July 1, 2016 and July 1, 2017~~ funds  
39 July 1, 2021 through July 1, 2025, three million dollars under  
40 this paragraph shall first be distributed to the ~~general fund~~  
41 transportation information system account created by  
42 W.S. 31-1-204. This subsection is repealed effective July 1, 2026;

1 (c) The department shall credit to appropriate accounts  
2 based upon deductions from the taxes collected under this article  
3 in the following order:  
4

5 (ii) Deduct an amount collected on fuel used in  
6 snowmobiles, computed by multiplying the number of snowmobiles for  
7 which registration and user fees have been paid during the current  
8 fiscal year under W.S. 31-2-404(a)(i) and 31-2-409(a)(ii) times  
9 twenty-eight dollars and seventy-five cents (\$28.75) plus the  
10 number of gallons of gasoline used by snowmobiles for which  
11 registration fees have been paid during the current fiscal year  
12 under W.S. 31-2-404(a)(ii) times the current gasoline tax rate as  
13 defined by W.S. 39-17-104(a)(i). The number of gallons used by  
14 commercial snowmobiles shall be reported to the department by all  
15 businesses offering commercial snowmobile recreational leasing.  
16 Except as otherwise provided in this paragraph, the amounts  
17 computed shall be credited to a separate account to be expended by  
18 the department of state parks and cultural resources to improve  
19 snowmobile trails in Wyoming. If the department of state parks and  
20 cultural resources receives federal highway funds to be used for  
21 recreation purposes that may include snowmobile trails, the  
22 amounts computed under this paragraph shall be credited to the  
23 transportation information system account created by  
24 W.S. 31-1-204. This distribution to the transportation information  
25 system account is repealed effective July 1, 2026;  
26

27 (iii) Deduct an amount collected on fuel used in  
28 motorboats, computed by multiplying the number of motorboats  
29 numbered during the current fiscal year under W.S. 41-13-102 plus  
30 the number of nonresident motorboats for which aquatic invasive  
31 species fees have been paid during the immediately preceding fiscal  
32 year in accordance with W.S. 23-4-204 times twenty-eight dollars  
33 and seventy-five cents (\$28.75). Except as otherwise provided in  
34 this paragraph, the amount computed shall be credited to a separate  
35 account to be expended by the department of state parks and  
36 cultural resources to improve, construct, maintain, operate and  
37 ensure the safety of facilities for use by motorboats and motorboat  
38 users at state parks and state recreation areas and to provide  
39 grants to governmental entities for improvement, construction,  
40 maintenance, operation and ensuring the safety of publicly owned  
41 boating facilities at public parks and recreational facilities. If  
42 the department of state parks and cultural resources receives  
43 federal highway funds to be used for recreation purposes that may  
44 include boating facilities, the amounts computed under this  
45 paragraph shall be credited to the transportation information  
46 system account created by W.S. 31-1-204. This distribution to the

1 transportation information system account is repealed effective  
2 July 1, 2026;

3  
4 (iv) Deduct an amount collected on fuel used in off-  
5 road recreational vehicles, computed by multiplying the number of  
6 off-road recreational vehicles for which user registration fees  
7 have been paid during the current fiscal year under W.S. 31-2-  
8 703(a) times eighteen dollars and forty cents (\$18.40). Except as  
9 otherwise provided in this paragraph, the amount computed shall be  
10 credited to a separate account to be expended by the department of  
11 state parks and cultural resources to improve off-road  
12 recreational vehicle trails in Wyoming. If the department of state  
13 parks and cultural resources receives federal highway funds to be  
14 used for recreation purposes that may include off-road  
15 recreational vehicle trails, the amounts computed under this  
16 paragraph shall be credited to the transportation information  
17 system account created by W.S. 31-1-204. This distribution to the  
18 transportation information system account is repealed effective  
19 July 1, 2026.

20  
21 **Section 3.** The department of transportation and the  
22 department of enterprise technology services shall, based on  
23 historical usage over the last five (5) years, determine the  
24 percentage of use for each agency and political subdivision of the  
25 state using the revenue information system that was in use on  
26 July 1, 2020. Based on the percentage determined, each agency and  
27 political subdivision shall be assessed a user fee percentage of  
28 one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per year, which shall be paid  
29 from that agency's general fund appropriation for five (5) years.  
30 This section is repealed effective July 1, 2026.

31  
32 **Section 4.** The department of transportation shall apply for  
33 any federal funds available or that may become available through  
34 additional Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES)  
35 Act funding for purposes of replacing the revenue information  
36 system that was in use on July 1, 2020. If the department receives  
37 any federal funds, the funding distributed to the department by  
38 Section 3 of this act, W.S. 9-4-601(n) as created by this act and  
39 W.S. 39-14-801(e)(iv) as amended in this act shall be reduced by  
40 the amount of federal funds received."
