## PRE-RIDE CHECK LIST



*\*\*These lists are not all inclusive, but rather provide some base line recommendations from experienced riders of the WSSA \*\**

## DECISION POINTS

- NEVER RIDE ALONE!
- TELL SOMEONE WHERE YOU ARE GOING  
(Give expected return time)
- CHECK AVY AND WX REPORTS
- GIVE GROUP BRIEFINGS  
(let everyone know what the plan is for the day)
- HAVE AVY & SAFETY GEAR ON YOU  
(turn it on before you ride)
- GROUP COMMUNICATIONS CHECK  
(confirm all transceivers and radios working)
- AVOID KNOWN AVY AREAS
- CROSS AVY TERRAIN WITH A PLAN  
one at a time!
- DON'T RIDE ABOVE OTHERS
- ALWAYS Wear YOUR TETHER
- BE CURTIOUS ON GROOMED TRAILS  
(use hand signals, keep to the right)
- WAIT AT ALL ITERSECTIONS & TURNS  
(for all party members)
- IF SOMEONE IS MISSING...  
(Go back to last known location)
- IF YOUR LOST, STAY PUT!  
(Build a fire if you can, use your tools, prepare for the worst)
